ELO-Program Background



- The Expanded Learning Opportunities Program (ELO-P) provides funding for afterschool and summer school enrichment programs for kindergarten (including transitional kindergarten) through sixth grade as described in Education Code (EC) Section 46120.
- "Expanded learning" means before school, after school, summer, or intersession learning programs that focus on developing the academic, social, emotional, and physical needs and interests of pupils through hands-on, engaging learning experiences.
- It is the intent of the Legislature that expanded learning programs are pupil-centered, results driven, include community partners, and complement, but do not replicate, learning activities in the regular school day and school year.



ELO-Program Requirements



- LEAs shall prioritize services provided at school sites to Unduplicated Pupils (UPP), as determined by prior year percentages of pupils eligible for free and reduced-price meals.
- Every pupil attending a school operating a program is eligible to participate in the program, subject to program capacity.
- For 175-instructional-day in-person before or after school expanded learning opportunities that are no less than nine hours of combined instructional time and expanded learning opportunities per day.
- For at least 30 non-school days, with no less than nine hours of in-person expanded learning opportunities per day.
- The ELO Program Plan needs to be approved by the Governing Board in a public meeting and posted on the District's website prior to implementation.



CSD's Proposed Expanded Learning Opportunities Program Implementation Plan



- Integrate ELOP into our Extended Day Care Program Rename as "CSD Extended Day Programs"
- Provide ELOP funding for to support the expanded learning opportunities offerings by the district
- Provide ELOP funding for to support the expanded learning opportunities offerings by school sites and in partnership with the H&SC
- Communicate to our community about the Expanded Learning Opportunities Program options
- Invite all students who qualify for free or reduced meals to participate students will have their fees waived if they participate.
- ELOP begins in Summer 2022!

ELO-Program Funding



- The ELO Program was established beginning in fiscal year 2021–22 by Assembly Bill (AB) 130, Chapter 44, Statutes of 2021, as amended by AB 167, Chapter 252, Statutes of 2021.
- Funding for the ELO Program is provided in Item 6100-110-0001 of the Budget Act of 2021 (Senate Bill 129, Chapter 69, Statutes of 2021), and EC Section 46120(f).
- Funding based on prior year's Unduplicated Pupil (UPP)



CSD's ELO Program Allocation & Proposed Budget



- 2021-22 Total Allocation: \$397,356
- 2022-23 Expected Total Allocation: \$1,195,298
- Total Allocation: \$1,592,654
- Less allowable indirect administrative cost (6.02%): \$95,878
- CSD's Expected Total Budget for 2022-23: \$1,496,776

Proposed Budget Expenditures for 2022-23

- ELO Program Plan Support for District's and School Sites Expanded Learning Opportunities: \$600,000
- Cambrian Extended Day Program: \$896,776
