10.8 AB1200 Public Disclosure of Collective Bargaining Unit Agreement with California School Employees Association, Local 641:

AB1200 CSEA

Dr. Andrews, stated that Assembly Bill (AB) 1200 requires local education agencies to disclose publicly the provisions of all collective bargaining agreements before entering into a written agreement. The Santa Clara County has already approved the AB1200 as presented.
