





CAMBRIAN EDUCATIONAL FOUNDATION READ-A-THON

A huge thank you to the Cambrian Educational Foundation (CEF), which ran their annual Read-a-Thon in our schools over the past few months. The CEF's districtwide Read-a-Thon supports reading

and mental health resources across our district. The Read-a-Thon had 1766 registered readers; 1420 of whom logged more than 20 minutes. There was a total of 1,133,340.50 minutes read (18,889 Hours, or 787 Days, or 112 Weeks - so, more than 2 full years worth of reading) — fantastic! Over \$37,000 was raised to support our Mental Health Programs in Cambrian Schools. Thank you to the entire Cambrian community for your support of our amazing district!




