### RESOLUTION REGARDING SUFFICIENCY OF INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees of the Cambrian School District, in order to comply with the requirements of Education Code 60119 held a public hearing on:

**WHEREAS**, the governing board provided at least 10 calendar days' notice of the public hearing posted in at least three public places within the district that stated the time, place and purpose of the hearing, and;

**WHEREAS**, the governing board encouraged participation by parents, teachers, members of the community, and bargaining unit leaders in the public hearing, and;

**WHEREAS**, information provided at the public hearing and to the governing board at the public meeting detailed the extent to which textbooks and instructional materials were provided to all students, including English learners, in the district, and;

**WHEREAS**, the definition of "sufficient textbooks or instructional materials" means that each pupil has a textbook or instructional materials, or both, to use in class and to take home, and;

**WHEREAS**, sufficient textbooks and instructional materials were provided to each student, including English learners, in mathematics, science, history-social science, and English/language arts, including the English language development component of an adopted program, and;

**WHEREAS**, sufficient textbooks or instructional materials were provided to each pupil enrolled in foreign language or health classes;

**THEREFORE**, be it resolved that for the 2022-2023 school year, the Cambrian School District has provided each pupil with sufficient textbooks and instructional materials aligned to the academic content standards and consistent with the cycles and content of the curriculum frameworks.
