














### **READ-A-THON**

## **Developing CEF**

Steps taken to further develop the organisation



- Reviewed and amended all Bylaws and procedures
  - Bylaws went from 6 pages to 34
  - 10 operating procedures were developed and accepted.
- Regained compliance with IRS regulations
- Further strengthened relationships with CSD Board, CSD, HSCs and City Council
- Began development of 5 year plan


