





Actions/Next Steps


- Continue additional supplemental target instruction for ELA & Math for 6/7/8th grade using current data.


I feel safe at school

School climate / culture (Grades 4-6) • 608 Responses




I feel like I am part of this school.

Emotional Safety • 604 Responses




Students at this school are teased or picked on about their race or ethnicity.

I can talk to a teacher or other adult at this school about something that is bothering me.




What is the climate for staff?


