HIGHLIGHTS

- 2024 Fastbridge Data 74% 2nd-5th students scored low risk or on/above level in both reading and math
- Based on this Data students expected to achieve on CAASPP
- Early Reading 60% of K-1st student scored low risk
- Early Math 49% of our K-1st students scored low risk
- Reading intervention support for 1st 5th grade
 - 26 Students served & 73% showed significant growth
- 20 students served in our afternoon ELD Academy (Level 1 & 2)
- 59% of students making progress toward English Proficiency (ELPI 2023)

 - Empowerment 73% favorable (4th & 5th grade)

Parent Engagement Survey Results:

- Parents feel welcomed & valued when visiting the school
- Each Family's ethnicity and culture is valued



Chronic Absenteeism




Additional Targeted Support and Improvement


We are back to pre-pandemic levels of chronic absenteeism (~4%). We have worked collaboratively with families to understand their stories in order to provide support and resources that are available to them.


KINDERGARTEN & FIRST GRADE




SECOND - FIFTH GRADE Screening Data








Social and Emotional Behavioral Rating Scale
