

3 YEAR STRATEGIC PLAN

In June 2024, the CEF adopted a 3 year Strategic Plan that aligns with and supports the Cambrian School District's Strategic Plan and Local Control Accountability Plan.



4TH ANNUAL READ-A-THON

The CEF Read-a-thon grossed over \$47,000 that was used to provide teacher support and training in the district's Social Emotional Learning curriculum in addition to supporting other district-wide mental wellness resources.



COMMUNITY EVENTS & FUNDRAISERS

In addition to the Read-a-thon, the CEF made significant progress expanding our presence and name recognition through community fundraisers like our first ever Shoe Drive and a special family night at Golfland. We also sponsored two student & family coding events and hosted a booth at the Cambrian School District Wellness Fair.

SOCIAL EMOTIONAL LEARNING & MENTAL WELLNESS

Through the funds raised in our annual Read-a-thon, the CEF funds curriculum and professional development for teachers in Social Emotional Learning. Additionally, we supplement mental health and wellness resources across the school district.

FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR MUSIC, ART, & STEM PROGRAMS

The CEF utilizes our non-profit status and ability to receive Corporate Match to double donations to enrichment programs. This support allows all students to have access to these programs, creating a vibrant and thriving program across all grade levels.

DISTRICT-WIDE ENRICHMENT PROGRAMS

Family Night of Code, a family coding event, and the Great Cambrian Code-Off, a student and family coding competition, were both well attended and meet requests from our community for more STEM programs across the district.


