# **Extended School Year**



An annual extension of the school year for students with Individualized Education Programs (IEP) *that qualify for* Extended School Year.

IEP teams review student's progress on annual IEP goal/goals and determine if the student meets the criteria for ESY.

### Qualification criteria:

- Without ESY, would the student would not achieve their annual IEP goal/goals.
- Without ESY, student will regress in critical skills and/or difficulty in recovering those skills within a reasonable period of time.

- 19 day program
  - June 15-July 14
  - 4 days/week
  - 3.5 hours/day
- Integrated related services
- 10 classes with 8 students/class
- Instructional Delivery
  - Current plan is in-person
  - Located at Farnham elementary school

# **Summer Elevate Math**



Collaborative Partnership with Silicon Valley Education Foundation Elevate Math since 2008.

An annual summer intervention program to prepare students to successfully complete their next level Common Core math course.

<u>Elevate Math</u>'s goal is to redirect "<u>at-promise</u>" students back on a college and career-bound pathway.

- Targeted Rising 3rd 8th Graders
- 6 classes with 25 students/class
- Priorities based on High Needs students and Target Criteria
- 19 day program
- June 15 July 14
- 3.5 hours per day
- Instructional Delivery
  - Current plan is virtual
  - o Prefer in-person if feasible
- Estimated Expenditure: \$96K
  - SVEF Grant \$72K
  - LPSBG \$24K

# Reading Foundational Skills Boost



### **Program Design**

- Pre & Post Assessment (Fastbridge Early Reading)
- Benchmark Advance ELA Foundational Literacy Skills Focus
- Balanced with SEL/Enrichment activities: Music; Art; Games; Nutrition
- Social-Emotional Learning
- 12 days
  - 3 weeks
  - 4 days/week (M, T, W & R)
  - 3 hours/day
  - 36 hours

### Targeted Rising 1st & 2nd Graders

- 8 Rising 1st Grade Classes
- 8 Rising 2nd Grade Classes
- 12:1 student to teacher ratio
  - Morning & Afternoon stable groups
- Targeted Student Criteria
  - Priority to High Needs students
  - Below grade level standards
    - "High Risk" & "Some Risk"

## **Estimated Expenditure:**

- \$100K
- AB86 Expanded Learning Grant

# Targeted English Language Development

Estimated Expenditure: \$25K AB86 Expanded Learning Grant

- Based on ELPAC Levels 1 8 2
- English Language Development
- Small student to teacher ratio
- Stable groups



- Staff Next Steps:
  - Secure and fill positions for ESY and Summer Elevate Math
  - Identify students who meets criteria for programs.
    - Priority will be based on High Needs, academic, and social-emotional needs
  - Post and secure staffing
