10.1 Return to In-Person Learning and Instruction:

Dr. Andrews provided an update on the new requirements and guidelines sent out by the California Public Health Department. Cambrian School District will continue with a gradual phased-in approach to return once the Santa Clara County moves to the red tier for 5 days. Dr. Andrews shared that once we enter the red tier, communication will go out to all of our families with a confirmed start date and we will begin with our youngest students (TK-2) first. Cambrian's reopening plan will continue to maintain a degree of fluidity as changes are presented by state and local health departments.

10.2 2019-20 Audited Financial Statements:

Ms. Joyce Peters from the auditing firm of EideBailly presented the audited financial statements for the Cambrian School District as well as the Performance Audit for the Measure I Bond. Ms. Peters reported that the District had a clean audit without any findings of misstatements or non-compliance in State or Federal programs.

10.3 Governor's Budget Proposal (January 2021):

Ms. Penny Timboe, Chief Financial Officer, presented the Governor's proposed 2021-21 State Budget and what it means for the Cambrian School District. She highlighted the themes for the 2020-21 State Budget and reviewed the Local Control Funding Formula funding factors. The Governor's budget reflects the current COVID-19 pandemic and continues to prioritize students with disabilities.

Governor's Budget

10.4 <u>Technology Plan Update and Measure R Technology Options</u>:

Mr. Matt Hill, Director of Educational Technology, and Mr. Mujtaba Rauf, Director of Informational Technology, presented an update on the Cambrian School District Technology Plan and three possible options for Student Device Programs using Measure R Bond funds. Staff recommended expanding the student device ratios to:

- Grades 2-5 to one device per student (1:1)
- Grades 6-8 remain at one device per student (1:1)
- Grades PK-1 remain at one device per three students (3:1)

In addition, the District will begin to explore a Take Home Device Program for grades 6-8.

On a motion by Mr. Middleton, seconded by Mrs. Gillis, the Board approved the 1:1 Student

Device Ratio for grades 2-5, using Measure R Bond funds and allow staff to move forward with exploring a Take Home Device Program for grades 6-8. Motion **CARRIED** 4-0
