9.1 <u>Budget: 2022-23 Audited Financial Statements:</u> Paul Pham from Chavan & Associates, LLP, shared the audited financial statements for the District and Measure R for the 2022-23 fiscal year. The purpose of the audit was to provide an objective independent examination of the District's financial statements. The report included aspects of the district's financial statements and whether they are presented accurately and fairly, in all material respects, in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America.

The Resolution will allow Cambrian to increase charges on new residential and new commercial development project per the 2024 Developer Fee Justification Study showing justification to increase developer fees.

They shared some highlights from the three initiatives, feedback received from parents, guardians, staff, and community input, and the top technology priorities for moving forward.
